TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

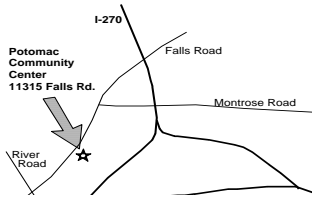
1. **Entry deadline: May 12, 2010. Entries received after May 12 may be denied.**
2. Open singles, semis and final are best of 7. All other matches are best of 5 games. Time-out is only allowed in umpired Open semis and final matches. Winners (and perhaps runners-up) of each RR advance to single elimination draw. Non-rated players may enter any event but will not advance to SE draw in rated events. Doubles are single elimination.
3. 14 Butterfly tables, Nittaku 3-star premium 40mm orange balls. Only USATT-approved equipment will be used. New USATT rules & regulations apply. Wood floor is used.
4. Proof of USATT membership will be required. Membership may be purchased at the tournament: \$40 yearly (\$20 Junior 17 and younger), \$105 for 3 years. One time pass for \$10.
5. Players must check in at least **30 min.** before the starting time of their entered events.
6. Any player abusing equipment or harassing tournament officials will be disqualified immediately. Anyone deliberately defaulting a match may, at the tournament officials discretion, be forfeited all prizes.
7. Latest ratings will be used. Events may be combined or canceled due to lack of entries. Minimum 6 entries for double event.
8. **Entry and fee must be received by May 12 to avoid \$5 late fee charge.**
9. **USATT dress code will be enforced.**
10. **Full refund if cancellation is made one day before the event time.**

DIRECTIONS:

1. From East: Take Washington Capital Beltway 495 West, Exit 35 onto I-270 North, get off Montrose Rd. West (Exit 4B), turn left onto Falls Rd.(Rt.189) South to Potomac Community Center (on the left side).
2. From South: Take Washington Capital Beltway 495 North, take River Road West (exit 39A, towards Potomac), turn right onto Falls Rd. North to Potomac Community Center (on the right side).
